



# Adult Canoe Facts Sheet

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## Enclosed you will find:

**Registration Acknowledgement:** Check the information to make sure it is accurate.

**What to Bring List:** Use this to help you pack!

**Canteen List:** We have a camp store. Use this list to help you determine how much spending money to bring.

**Camper Health, Emergency and Authorized Information Form:** If you bring a child that you are not the legal guardian/parent of, you need to fill out a health history form for that child. Otherwise, no health form needs to be filled out for families.

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### ARRIVAL:

**What time do we arrive?** Thursday at 8:30am at Luther Point. People car pooling from Luther Park will leave at camp at 7:00am

**Where do we check in?** At the Dining Hall (follow Luther Point Rd. all the way until it ends)

**What will happen when we get there?** There will be staff to greet you and show you where to park. You will need to check-in.

**Do we need to check in at registration even if we have already paid?** Yes, to make sure you have arrived.

### DEPARTURE:

**What time do we leave?** The trip will be back at camp by 5:00pm on Friday. Departure will be soon after we clean and return gear.

**What if we leave something at Luther Point?** Please check for Lost and Found items on display at the Dining Hall during departure times. We only keep items for two weeks and then they are given to a local charity.

### HEALTH AND SAFETY ANSWERS:

**What do I do with the Camper Health Form you sent me?** In order to make sure we are able to provide you appropriate and proper medical care if needed, we need to have a completed health form.

**Does I need a physical by a physician?** We recommend one every two years but it is not required.

**When does Luther Point need the Health Form?** Either mail it in two weeks before your start date or bring the signed form with you to camp at check-in time.

**Will we be safe?** The staff is highly trained. There are Emergency Responders available 24 hours a day no matter where you are. We have an AED and an EMT at camp. A doctor is available on call. There are trained lifeguards at the beach and trained counselors at the recreation areas.

**What about insurance?** Each camper is covered primarily by their own insurance and secondarily by Luther Point's Accident Insurance Policy.

### MISC QUESTIONS:

**What if I have a food allergy?** Let us know and we will accommodate you to the best of our ability.


**May I bring my fishing pole?** Yes, but don't forget your Wisconsin license. The DNR does patrol the river.

## MONEY ANSWERS:

### If I cancel, will I get my deposit refunded?

The required deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable after May 1. If cancellation occurs prior to May 1, the deposit will be refunded less a \$15 processing fee.

### When is the rest of my payment due?

Mail the final payment at least two weeks in advance of your start date or you can pay the remainder when you check-out on Sunday.
