

Family Camp Fact Sheet

COME EARLY TO CELEBRATE!!

Come early on Sunday and join us for our End of Summer Celebration. We will have our annual

pig roast, craft and quilt action, and craft sale, among other things. And of course, there will be plenty of camp activities for the kids!

HEALTH AND SAFETY ANSWERS:

What do I do with the Camper Health Form you sent me? If you are bringing a child that you are NOT the legal guardian/parent of, then you need to have the legal guardian/parent of that child fill out the form and sign it. Luther Point cannot allow any child to stay at camp without his or her legal guardian/parent unless a current health history form is filled out and signed by his/her legal guardian/parent.

Does the child need a physical by a physician? We recommend one every two years but it is not required.

When does Luther Point need the Health Form? Either mail it in two weeks before your start date or bring the signed form with you to camp at check-in time.

Will we be safe? The staff is highly trained. There are Emergency Responders available 24 hours a day no matter where you or your child are. We have an AED and an EMT at camp. A doctor is available on call. There are trained lifeguards at the beach and trained counselors at the recreation areas.

What about insurance? Each camper is covered primarily by their own insurance and secondarily by Luther Point's Accident Insurance Policy. If you need to have a health form for any child you are bringing, you must include a copy of his or her insurance and pharmacy cards.

IDEA! Label everything you bring with your name so if it gets misplaced people know who it belongs to.

ARRIVAL:

What time do I come? Sunday between 4:00 - 5:00 pm.

Where do I check-in? At the Retreat Center. We will collect any money you might owe and direct you towards your housing assignment. Even if you have paid in full, please check-in so that we know you have arrived.

What will happen when I get there? There will be summer staff to greet you and show you where to park. They will also help you carry your luggage and help you get settled into your accommodations.

DEPARTURE:

What time do we leave? Family Camp will end at around 11:30am on Friday, when closing campfire is over.

What if I leave something at Luther Point? Please check for Lost and Found items on display at the Dining Hall during departure times. We only keep items for two weeks and then they are given to a local charity.

CANTEEN (The Camp Store) SPENDING MONEY:

New Procedures for 2013!

We will no longer be utilizing Canteen Cards. Instead, each family's account balance will be maintained electronically. This will eliminate the chances for campers to lose their canteen spending money.

What will happen to my spending money? Your family will put money towards Canteen during check-in and it will be inputted into our accounting software. Purchases will be subtracted from the account balance electronically. Any money that is not spent will be reimbursed on Friday in the Dining Hall after closing campfire.

When is the canteen open? At check-in and departure times. Also, once in the afternoon and once in the evening while the campers are here.

How do I pay for crafts? Craft supplies are available for purchase during free time in the Craft Room and range from 25 cents to \$5. Purchases will be subtracted from the Canteen account balance.



What will I be doing at Luther Point? A typical day includes many of the following: Experiencing God - FUN - Games - Bible Study - Worship - Crafts - Swimming - Making New Friends - Discovering New Things - Singing - Food! - FUN - Hanging with counselors - Skits - Rest time - Night Hikes—and MUCH MORE

MONEY ANSWERS:

If I cancel, will I get my deposit refunded?

The required deposit of \$110 is non-refundable and non-transferable after May 1. If cancellation occurs prior to May 1, the deposit will be refunded less a \$15 processing fee.

When is the rest of my payment due? Mail the final payment at least two weeks in advance of your arrival or bring it with you.

What if my friend or I can't afford to come to Luther Point? If you need a campership, please download a form at LutherPoint.org or call us. No one is turned away from Luther Point because of inability to pay. The actual cost for each child to come to camp is more than the price we charge. The registration fee does not cover the full cost. We are very grateful to all the people who make it possible for kids to come to camp through their generous financial gifts.

Will an offering be collected at camp? Yes, every camper will learn about our mission, the New Life Community Center in Kisii, Kenya. They will have one opportunity to give during an evening canteen. Please talk with your camper about the amount you would like them to give from their canteen money.

Can I use a Credit Card? We accept Discover, Visa, & Mastercard.

MISC. QUESTIONS:

Can we bring a bicycle? Yes. Many people bring non-motorized bicycles (motorized are not allowed). Be sure to bring safety helmets, knee and elbow pads as well.

Will I be able to have a nap? Yes, there will be staff available to watch your children during free time.

What if I have a food allergy? Let us know and we will accommodate you to the best of our ability.

Where will we be staying and can we bring bedding instead of sleeping bags? Your family will be staying in the Retreat Center or a Family Cabin and you may bring bedding instead of sleeping bags. Each room in the Retreat Center has a double bed and three twin beds.

Do I need to bring towels, washcloths and soap? Yes.

Will my family be together for Bible study? We have Bible study groups for certain ages. The adults will all be together and the children will be divided into smaller age-appropriate groups.

May I bring my guitar? Yes, please bring a musical instrument and share your talents with us.


What if I can't sing? God said make a joyful noise not a pretty noise. No one will notice. Really!
